d. Horse Trails (KA) - Nina shared the preliminary map with Janice and Kathie Atencio. Kathie will address and map the remaining open space to the South of the neighborhood.

VI. New Business:

- a. Complaint(s) -
 - We are looking to more clearly define our complaints process. Mike Green is working on this.
 - Complaints on several lots regarding architectural changes that have not been approved or not been completed in time.
 - Recurrent complaints regarding use of lot for storage of debris,
 - Clearing of lots for blacktop parking, commercial use which is contrary to CEPOA covenants and county regulations - we have a formal complaint on this one. Janice will contact the lot owner in question and require them to cease and desist. She'll send out an email recapping their call. We will involve the lawyer if necessary.
- b. Annual Meeting we can't hold it at the firehouse this year due to Covid-19. Kathie Atencio will investigate conference call services that will allow for an operator to help facilitate muting and questions, allowing members to join via video call, internet or phone. Janice will send language for an email that Nina will send to the membership regarding the fact that we won't be having an annual meeting at the firestation
